HOMEBUILDING PROGRAM: MHFH OFFERS HOMEOWNERSHIP AND ASSET BUILDING OPPORTUNITIES NOT FOUND ANYWHERE ELSE TO LOW-MODERATE FAMILIES WHO LIVE AND/OR WORK IN THE GREATER MORRIS COUNTY AREA. WE OFFER AN AFFORDABLE MORTGAGE WITH A MORTGAGE PAYMENT SIGNIFICANTLY LESS THAN WHAT OUR FAMILIES PAID IN RENT.
